I like staying up late, but it's difficult for me to concentrate sometimes. To be honest, I've probably slept in his class like twice. That's just because I'm not used to an environment like that. Nevertheless, I think this class is great!
- none for instructor, but the students who were in this FTV class need improvement though, I wish there was a more interactive and fun crowd of students to be taught but that's not something you can choose rather just hope for the best next time.
- The only aspect that could potentially be improved would be to further ensure that for the final project, where students got to take a survey ahead of time to pick the roles they most wanted/had the most skill to perform (editor, director, actor, camera), that all teams are equally distributed. One of the groups, when they had first gotten together to distribute roles, had four members all wish to be editor. While it is possible that some of them had not selected editor for their top choice and then changed their mind or simply never filled out the form, perhaps making the survey a short answer (instead of a multiple choice) survey would work more favorably. That way each student has to explain why they should be assigned the role they wish, as well as what role they would not prefer and why, and then it would be up to the instructor's discretion which roles everyone gets (and anyone who does not fill out the survey is automatically placed in the roles that are less popular and need more people to fill). Afterwards, if all group members involved agree, there can be switching/sharing of roles if necessary.

- For me personally the advice I would give is to learn about the editing software, Adobe Premiere Pro. I've never had any use for it until I joined this class. Before I joined this class I was using CapCut. During covid I randomly discovered my talent for editing through CapCut in 2020. Since then, I've used capcut for everything under the sun. So when premiere was introduced, I was upset because I could simply use capcut. But eventually, I had to study it. I guess what I'm saying is that sometimes it's important to try something new. I'm still learning premiere, but it's gonna be a long precess.
- Only advice I may give is just to learn how to do the basics of editing before going into the class or start learning in advance, as it is an extremely important part of film / movie creation and it's something that could have an entire course for, however there isn't that much time focused on it specifically. The course isn't the problem nor the assignments, it is just really hard to fit so many things in the singular subject of FTV after all over the semester. So just advising people to do more editing on their own outside of class I would probably do, and tell them to rent out equipment from Cheq as soon as possible.
- I guess what I wish I knew was that storyboards are a LOT harder to make than I anticipated. As for advice, I just hope that you watched enough films to know what you're going to talk about for the first few projects.
- I didn't know the course would be as fundamental as it was, as someone very excited about film and having had experience with it previously, the course was definitely a little slow and elementary to me. Someone taking this class, I would say it's really fun but it is very fundamental.
